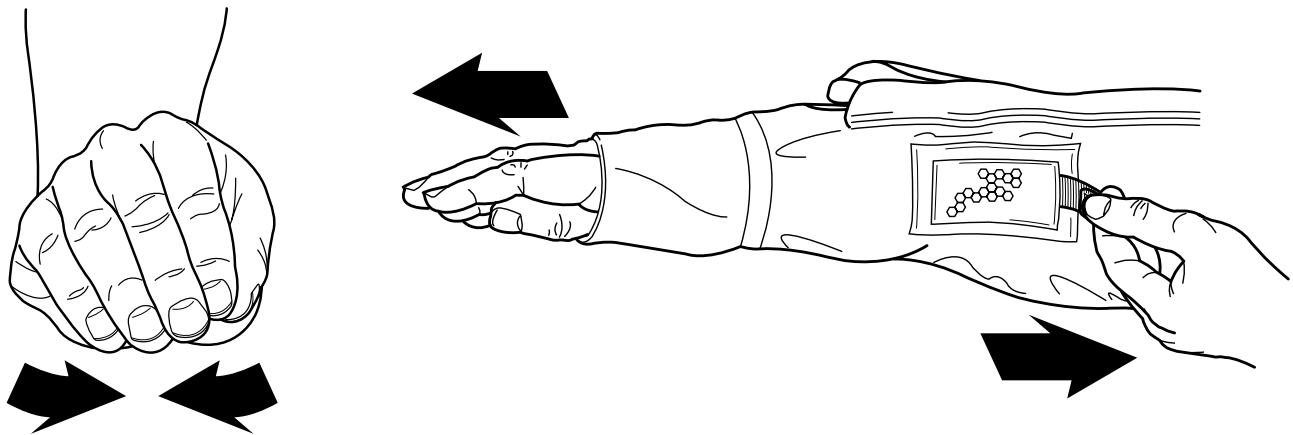


# Ocean Commander Cuff Orientation - Donning

1. Curl fingers and tuck in thumb for easy passage through the wrist seal.
2. Slowly slide the arm into the sleeve until the hand reaches the wrist seal, without pushing the hand through.
3. Using the opposite hand, grasp the donning strap located on the sleeve that is being donned.
4. Pull the donning strap as the hand is gently pushed through the wrist seal.
5. Repeat steps 1-4 for the other arm.

**NOTE: To increase comfort and protection: ensure insulating undergarments are not sandwiched between seals and skin. Flatten any folds or rolls of the seals against the skin.**



**Ocean Commander seals** fit snug because it's important to have a waterproof seal on the wrists and neck when entering the water, especially if it's cold. An initial discomfort can be expected after donning before entering the water. **DO NOT** be alarmed, this condition is temporary.

In an immersion situation, the coldness of the water reduces the swelling making the fit more comfortable. In fact, the wrist

size may reduce enough to allow leakage if the seal is not close to the skin. Survival time is directly related to the dryness inside the suit.

Ocean Commanders are engineered to save lives in harsh environments; the seals are a key component in this system.
