

GRAB the Stick!

Incredibly easy to use, the Rescue Stick from Mustang Survival provides rapid flotation assistance to someone in danger of drowning. The baton-shaped Rescue Stick inflates in seconds on contact with water into a large horseshoe shape that can keep the person afloat with head above water until help arrives. The Rescue Stick won the 2007 Innovation Award for Safety at the Marine Aftermarket Accessories Tradeshow, sponsored by the National Marine Manufacturers Association (NMMA).

Measuring only 14 inches in length and weighing just less than a pound, the Rescue Stick is possibly the most versatile rescue flotation device available. Easily stowed in a boat, vehicle, backpack or by the pool, it will be accessible when and where you need it. Since it is literally shaped like a stick, it is far easier to throw than a conventional ring-shaped life preserver and can be thrown much farther. From first responder to recreational boater to pool owner, the Rescue Stick is an invaluable life-saving aid. It is also easy to repack and reuse with a replacement handle and CO2 cylinder.

Vue Don't Sway!

The **Trailer Sway Control** program on the 2008 Saturn Vue makes hauling outdoor toys such as PWC safer and easier. The feature is integrated into the new crossover utility vehicle's standard StabiliTrak system. When the system detects that the trailer is swaying, it applies the vehicle's brakes, independently of the driver, to help stabilize the vehicle. The StabiliTrak indicator light will flash on the gauge cluster to signal the driver to slow down. If trailer sway continues, StabiliTrak will reduce engine torque to slow the vehicle. Common causes of sway include improper trailer weight balance, excessive speed, uneven roads and strong side winds. The Vue XE AWD, XR FWD and XR AWD (all 3.6L V6s) can tow up to 3,500 lbs. Vue XE FWD (2.4 L4) and Vue Green Line hybrid (2.4 L4) both have 1,500 lb. towing capacities.
